## CONTEST, REGISTRATION, AUDITION RULES, AND RELEASE

By registering for this competition, the participant acknowledges having read, fully understands, and accepts all contest rules.

### GRAND PRIZE

One participant will be chosen to be the winner of Wayne County Idol at the Wayne County Fairgrounds on June 24, 2023, to win \$1,000 (One thousand dollars). Winner is solely responsible for any associated taxes.

### TWO OPEN AUDITION NIGHTS AT FRICKER'S

1. **June 07, 2023**, 6pm-8pm at Fricker's in Richmond. 5:30pm-6pm check-in with valid I.D. 2. **June 14, 2023**, 6pm-8pm at Fricker's in Richmond. 5:30pm-6pm check-in with valid I.D. All contestants must attend *one* of the Open Auditions at Fricker's. Each participant signs a release form prior to performing in the Wayne County Idol competition. Contestants will sing approximately THIRTY seconds of one song of their choice, a cappella, with no instrument or musical accompaniment, earbuds, headphones, speakers, or otherwise.

### SEMI-FINALS COMPETITION AT WAYNE COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS, RICHMOND, IN

- **June 21, 2023** - Check in with valid I.D. begins at **5:30pm**. **Competition is 6pm-8pm** Semi-Finalists are to email a karaoke-style music mp3 file with any special instructions to [wcidol@kicks96.com](mailto:wcidol@kicks96.com) by noon on Tuesday, June 20. If a music file is not received by that time, participants may sing a cappella during the performance.
- **Semi-finalists will sing approximately SIXTY seconds of the song of their choice.** If a semi-finals contestant does not show up, they may forfeit their spot in the contest. Semi-finalists **MUST** be checked in by 6pm or they may forfeit their spot as a finalist.
- Participants are permitted to play an acoustic instrument for the semi-final event if they choose.

### FINALS COMPETITION AT WAYNE COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS, RICHMOND, IN

- **June 24, 2023.** Check in with valid I.D. begins at **4:30pm**. **Competition is 5pm-7pm.** Finalists are to email a karaoke-style music mp3 file with any special instructions to [wcidol@kicks96.com](mailto:wcidol@kicks96.com) by noon on Friday, June 23. If a music file is not received by this time, participants may sing a cappella during the performance. **Music files MUST be labeled with the first & second song (should they make it to the second round of finals).**
- Finalists should arrive prepared to potentially participate in two rounds. In the **first round, contestants will sing NINETY SECONDS of their choice.** There will be a half-way point elimination, followed by the **second round, where finalists will sing a full song.**
- Finalists **MUST** be checked in by 5pm or they may forfeit their spot as a finalist.
- Participants are permitted to play an acoustic instrument for the finals event if they choose.

## **GENERAL CONDITIONS**

By participating, you agree that KICKS 96, 101.7 The Point, 95.3 The Legend and sponsors may use your audio, image, or likeness in current and future promotions without compensation. Participants and those accompanying participants to the events who do not wish to be photographed, recorded, or do not agree with these terms should not enter the event venue.

## **WHAT TO WEAR**

Since video and photographs are secured during the event, copyright restrictions require participants not wear apparel or carry items with designer names, corporate or sports team names or logos, copyrighted images, celebrity names or images (living or dead), cartoon character images or messages/words that may be deemed inappropriate. The stations reserve the right to require participants to remove such clothing, turn it inside out or cover it with additional clothing before participating in Wayne County Idol. Any refusal to accommodate such requests will result in the contestant's disqualification.

## **PARTICIPANTS WITH DISABILITIES**

## **ELIGIBILITY**

1. Previous Wayne County Idol winners are not eligible to compete.
2. Participation is open to U.S. residents of at least 18 years of age as of Wednesday, June 7, 2023 (born on or before June 6, 2005).
3. Persons in any of the following categories are NOT eligible to compete in Wayne County Idol:
  - a) Employees of Brewer Broadcasting, Fricker's & event sponsors on or after June 7, 2023.
  - b) Immediate family members of current employees of Brewer Broadcasting or event sponsors (defined as spouse, IRS dependent, or biological, adoptive or stepparent or stepsibling).
  - c) Employees and immediate family members of other radio stations (defined as spouse, IRS dependent, or biological, adoptive or stepparent or stepsibling).
  - d) Those who reside in the same household as any person in any of the previous categories.

## **DISQUALIFICATIONS**

KICKS 96, 101.7 The Point, 95.3 The Legend reserves the right to remove anyone from the competition for any reason or for no reason at all, including without limitation, violation of any portion of these rules, or tampering with the entry process or the audition process. Procedures, dates, locations, prizes, and rules are subject to change without notification. Contestants are encouraged to check the websites for the most up-to-date information.

## **FORCE MAJEURE**

KICKS 96, 101.7 The Point, 95.3 The Legend and sponsors reserve the right, without prior notice and at any time, to terminate the Wayne County Idol competition, in whole or in part, or modify competition in any way, should it deem the competition is corrupted or that fraud or technical problems, failures or malfunctions have destroyed or severely undermined the proper play, integrity, and/or feasibility of the competition.

In the event KICKS 96, 101.7 The Point, 95.3 The Legend and sponsors are prevented from continuing with the competition by any event beyond its control, including but not limited to fire, flood, natural or man-made health epidemic, earthquake, explosion, labor dispute or strike, act of God or public enemy, equipment failure, riot or civil disturbance, terrorist threat or activity, war (declared or undeclared) or any federal, state, provincial or local government law, order, or regulation, public health crisis, order of any court or jurisdiction, or other cause not reasonably within Station and Sponsor control (each a "Force Majeure" event or occurrence), then subject to any governmental approval which may be required, KICKS 96, 101.7 The Point, 95.3 The Legend and sponsors shall have the right to modify, suspend, extend or terminate the competition.

General contest rules also apply.
